ENLENS HAS APPROVED TWO NEW PROJECTS

In October 2023, ENLENS approved two new projects, thereby stimulating interdisciplinary cross-faculty research. The first project, entitled "Optimizing Energy Efficiency and Policy for Green Hydrogen Production and Market Adoption," focuses on the exploration of improving energy efficiency in green hydrogen production using paired electrolysis. This project also encompasses discussions about its commercialization and market adoption potential. The project will be coordinated by Amanda Amanda C. Garcia (HIMS) and Panikos Georgallis (EB).

The second project, entitled "Climate finance and energy minerals: A systems approach", adopts a systems approach to study how the politics of implementation affect responsible energy mineral production and access to

modern energy services in Sub-Saharan Africa, emphasizing clean energy. The project will be developed by Ruth D. Carlitz (FMG) and Michelle Westermann-Behaylo (EB).

These two projects analyze opportunities for joint progress on SDG 1 (No Poverty), SDG 7 (Affordable and clean energy), SDG 12 (Responsible consumption and production), SDG 13 (Climate Action), SDG 15 (Life on land), and SDG 17 (Partnership for the goals). They demonstrate the University of Amsterdam's unique expertise in researching the energy transition and Sustainable Development Goals from an interdisciplinary perspective.
